### Campaign Coordinator

Lutheran Metropolitan Ministry in partnership with the Ohio Transformation Fund (OTF) and Just Leadership USA (JLUSA), is seeking a coordinator for its “#JustUs” campaign in Ohio.

#### Company Description

A mission-driven organization, Lutheran Metropolitan Ministry (LMM) serves people in Northeast Ohio and walks with them on their road to self-sufficiency. LMM helps empower people to overcome barriers, obtain job skills, gain employment, locate safe and stable housing, access counseling and support services, stay out of prison, and secure second chances in community. Our mission is to promote shalom (peace, well-being) and justice (right relationships) through a Christian ministry of service and advocacy with those who are oppressed, forgotten and hurting.

#### Position Summary

The Campaign Coordinator is a collaboration between Lutheran Metropolitan Ministry (LMM), Ohio Transformation Fund (OTF) and Just Leadership USA (JLUSA) to advance the “Compassion Over Cages” Campaign. “Compassion Over Cages” is a statewide campaign aimed at developing emergency management plans to protect individuals who are incarcerated during times of crisis. This initiative aligns with LMM’s commitment to serve individuals who are currently or recently incarcerated. It also aligns with LMM’s Commitment to systems change through statewide advocacy. The Campaign Coordinator will be a staff partner of LMM but will be assigned to work directly with OTF to coordinate this campaign. **This is a temporary assignment (minimum 12 months).**

#### Some of the duties include:

- Coordinate action and communications between JLUSA, OTF, and several grassroots advocacy partners within Ohio.
- Regularly interact with organizers and leaders who have been directly impacted by the criminal-punishment system, to coordinate online as well as in-person advocacy.
- Collaborate closely with researchers and allied policy experts to ensure the specific plans being developed remain true to the values and goals of the campaign.
- Interface with lobbyists and high-level local and state government officials who may be targets of persuasion or collaborators in developing an Ohio version of the emergency-management plan(s).
- Interact with media from time-to-time to create opportunities for other directly-impacted leaders to speak about the campaign. The coordinator may also act as a spokesperson at times.
- Develop and maintain an accurate report of campaign progress to date
- Communicate regularly with LMM's Director of Advocacy regarding the progress of the campaign.

#### Qualifications

Our ideal candidate has a Bachelor’s degree or relevant work and/or lived experience, must reside in the State of Ohio, and has demonstrated knowledge and understanding of policies and procedures within the criminal justice system. Connection with government officials, preferred. In state travel required; candidates must have a valid Ohio driver’s license, reliable transportation and proof of insurance.
